The student resources are hosted by Google Drive and has a very high level of Web browser compatibility. Ensure your web browser is up-to-date. Access problems reside with the users computer, software or configuration. You can trouble shoot problems by using a different computer. A computer, tablet or smartphone that has a normal configuration will have no access problems.

All students

Quiz questions and crossword puzzles are formulated from the information found in the Learners Guide that accompanies the course. You must attempt each question in every quiz & every crossword puzzle question. If you are unclear about what a particular question may be asking, answer it using your own interpretation of what you think the question is asking or ask for clarification. Always re-read the question when you have completed the answer to ensure you have answered fully and addressed all aspects of the question using the language and terms used in class.

It is painfully obvious when a question is answered by pasting information from the internet as the language and terminology does not match those used in the course material.

Tutorial classes attended at the College

Many students prefer face to face teaching where they are free to ask questions and feel they gain a better grasp of the course material, but find it difficult to attend 10 weekly classes. At Om Shanti College you have have the best of both worlds, the freedom of flexible learning with the correspondence model with the benefit of face to face feedback. Students have commented they get the best feedback and clarity during the quiz marking sessions. So you can listen to the class recordings, while consulting the presentation slides and complete the quizzes. Throughout your 10 weeks study you will attend three 90 minute quiz making classes (30 minutes for each quiz) to assess your understanding of the work. Bring a red or coloured pen to mark your own quiz paper. After marking in class your quizzes will be taken up and formally assessed.

You will also need to bring your completed crossword puzzle that correspond to the quizzes being marked.

Correspondence students

As you work through the course material send in your completed quizzes & crossword puzzles as you finish them rather than the whole lot in one go. That way I can identify any problems you may be having with the course material as you proceed through the course.

Scan and email your completed quizzes, or retype the questions in the body of an email message. Scan your crossword puzzles and email them to me.

Assessment

Anatomy & Physiology II is a pre-requisite for Pathology so you must complete anatomy and physiology before you can go on to study Pathology, though both subjects can be studied concurrently. You must satisfactorily completed all quizzes and crossword puzzles before receiving the final assessment paper for each subject.

The Final Assessment paper takes the form of a big quiz which covers material covered in the whole course. It will be given to you at the final class or when you have satisfactorily competed all quizzes & crossword puzzles. Correspondence students will have have their final paper emailed to them.

You must conclude your studies within a 12 week period you must ask for an extension if you will have difficulty with this timeframe. Extensions must be negotiated with me or the College otherwise a late assessment fee will apply.
